

Evidence of Identity - White Card Course

You are required to show at least 100 points of identification, within these documents you must show your photo, date of birth (minimum 14 years of age), signature and current residential address.

ID requirements may vary depending on special circumstances:

- If you are an overseas person recently arrived in Australia less than 6 weeks - Go to part A
- If you are a school student - Go to part B
- If you are an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander - Go to part C

Secondary - 25 points value each

<p>If using credit/savings cards or statements (up to a maximum of 2), these must be from different financial institutions. One credit/savings card or statement equates to 25 points, two equals 50 points. A credit/savings card or statement from non-Australian banks can be accepted ONLY if the bank has representation in Australia.</p> <p>Photocopied or certified documents are NOT accepted. If the document was issued electronically, for example a utility bill emailed to you or telephone account on your phone app, this can be accepted.</p>			

Other Options

Part A - Overseas persons recently arrived in Australia less than six weeks (points system does not apply)		
International passport OR International documents of identity equals to a passport (eg diplomatic documents and documents issued to refugees)	AND	Australian or overseas driver's license OR Credit/saving account card
Part B - Secondary school sector (points system does not apply)		
OPTION 1 Australian Birth Certificate/card (minimum 14 years) issued by the Registrar of Births Deaths and Marriages OR Australian Citizenship Certificate OR Current Australian driver's licence or learner driver's licence OR International travel documents including a current passport or a passport which has expired within the last two years, but has not been cancelled.	OPTION 2 Written statement on school letterhead confirming the student's name and date of birth: 1.Name of school and location 2.Name and title of school official 3.Date of statement	OPTION 3 Student ID card that contains the school crest/seal, photo, student's name and date of birth
Part C - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders (points system does not apply)		
Two written statements on organisational/company letterhead verifying the person's identification from authorised referees. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chairperson, secretary or CEO of an incorporated Indigenous organisation (including land councils, community councils, housing organisations etc). • Community development employment projects coordinator. • School principal. • School counsellor. • Minister of religion. • Treating health professional or manager in Aboriginal medical services. • Centrelink staff, Centrelink agent or other government employee of at least five years
